PROJECT: TESTING A CLAIM

Due date: Friday, May 2nd

Your mission is to explore, test, and draw a conclusion of the validity of a claim made in the media.

You may test the claim using any of the methods discussed in Chapter 7. You must include the following in your final report:

- Claim & source of claim (ex. source may be a website or magazine) (5 points)
- 2. Data collected to test the claim (10 points)
- 3. Test the claim (show **all** steps for a hypothesis test, including assumptions) (20 points)
- 4. Draw a conclusion based on the claim, including your opinion. (2-3 sentences) (10 points)
- Do you think all the assumptions were met? Is your test valid? Explain. (2-3 sentences)(5 points)

Additional points can be earned for: extreme neatness, creativity, presentation, and professional appearance

Examples (these cannot be used!!)

#1. Average number of text messages per day for teens. (hypothesis test for sample mean)

#2. Do teens text message while driving? (hypothesis test for sample proportion)

HINT: Use google to search your interest.

For example #1, search <u>average number of text messages per day for teens</u>

For example #2, search percent of teens text messaging while driving

No more than two groups will be testing the exact same claim so show me your claim ASAP!!!
