Welcome to AP Calculus AB. I look forward to working with all of my students this year. This course requires a strong knowledge of Pre Calculus which will allow you to fully grasp Calculus concepts and techniques. I expect all my students to attend class regularly, be prepared for class, study and learn the material, and be respectful of the learning environment.

Preparation for class: All students should have a math notebook, (3-ring binder with notebook paper and graph paper). An organized notebook is a starting point to success in the class. A TI-84 Graphing Calculator is required for this course.

Homework: Homework is assigned per section and will be checked periodically. At the beginning of each chapter an assignment syllabus will be given. You are expected to read this syllabus on a daily basis. All problems must be attempted to receive full credit. Students should always check their answers and retry missed questions.

All tests and quizzes are designated on each chapter syllabus and will be verbally announced in class. Completing, checking, and re-doing missed homework questions and reviewing class notes are the best way to prepare for a test or quiz.
